He has published several peer-reviewed papers and he is a member of several dental and orthodontic Societies, including SIDO, EOS, IBO, EBO, ANDI and SIOI.

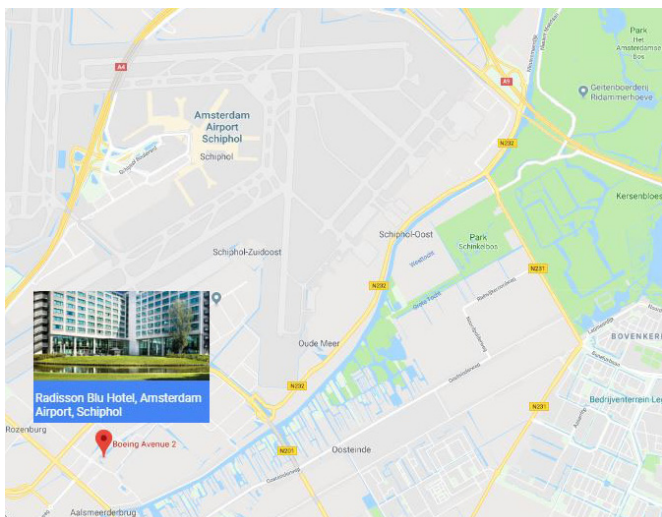
